It is noteworthy to mention that during a data cleaning exercise, a case initially recorded as “Locations Pending” is now re-classified as a case initially confirmed from Exuma. Therefore, the total number of confirmed cases for Exuma increased by one (1), and the number of cases for “Locations Pending” was decreased by one (1).
