



TARGETED GROUPS



NEW REGISTRATIONS

 Entitled voters who are 18 years of age and above and not on the current (permanent) register.

TRANSFERS

- Registrants who have moved from one place of occupancy to another for a period of 90 days or more.
- LEGAL NAME CHANGES

VOTER'S REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS



- I) An applicant applying to register to vote must prove the following:
 - I. That he/she is a citizen of The Bahamas
 - II. Must be 18 years or older, not subject to any legal incapacity.
 - III. That he/she has resided in a particular constituency for at least three (3) months

2) Documentary Proof of Bahamian Citizenship

- A Bahamian Passport:- The principle document that should be presented as proof of Citizenship, OR
- The Old Voters Card:- An applicant who presents and old voter's card is requested to also produce a valid Bahamian Birth Certificate as proof of citizenship, OR
- III. The Bahamian Citizenship Certificate or Registration of Naturalization: an applicant must also present his/her Birth Certificate.
- IV. The Bahamian Birth Certificate: Must be presented with a government ID, along with his/her mother's Bahamian Passport OR Voters Card, OR mothers Bahamian Birth Certificate and government issued ID.

- CONTINUOUS EDITING
- THE REGISTER IS CONTINUOUSLY PURGED OF DECEASED PERSONS
- NEW REGISTRANTS ARE ADDED DAILY
- TRANSFERS ARE PROCESSED DAILY
- INCARCERATED PERSONS VOTING RIGHTS ARE SUSPENDED
- SCRUTINEERS TO TEST THE VALIDITY OF THE REGISTER ON THE GROUND
